Autism Art is a program being developed by the Autism Society of Greater Orlando to give adults with autism a meaningful day program that allows them to express themselves through art. The individuals with autism will create pieces and will then display them in the surrounding areas as well as art fairs and gallery showings throughout the year. The pieces will be available for purchase with all proceeds benefitting the artist. ASGO will underwrite the program by paying for the certified art teacher/ board certified assistant behavior analyst. The participants will be responsible for a material fee per piece. We are very excited about this new program and the doors it can open.

Specifics Related to the Program:

- 1. The ultimate goal for this program is to provide an outlet for individuals with autism to express themselves in unique ways while providing a meaningful way to spend their days and make money.
- 2. For consideration into the Autism Art program, you must read the introductory information, complete and submit the attached application, and complete an interview.
- 3. There are a limited number of spots available.
- 4. The first group of selected individuals with autism will receive "Charter Member" status and will be recognized as originators of the program.
- 5. The program will run on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays from 10:00 AM 12:00 PM with lunch running from 12:00 PM 12:30 PM (NOTE: Lunch is not provided bag lunches will be required to be brought every day). Lunch time will allow for social time and talking about their art to prepare for the Gallery Showing and/or Art Fair presentations.
- 6. The sessions will be held at the ASGO Office located at 1650 Sand Lake Rd #240 Orlando, FL 32809.
- 7. Adult Supervision is required for all participating individuals.
- 8. The price to participate is for materials only. Prices will be based on the size and complexity of the piece. Normally, the material cost will be 50% of the sale price of the art piece. ASGO will cover the entire cost of the Art Instructor/Behavior Analyst working with the program.
- 9. All completed art work will be held at the ASGO Office and then revealed at the Gallery Shows or Art Fairs. At that time, the artists will present their pieces, speak to potential buyers, and sell their art pieces where they will keep 100% of the proceeds from the sale. At that time, artists can also take additional orders to complete after the show thereby creating a client list that they can work with for additional sales.
