ASGO's 2019 Autism Walk & Family Fun Day

The Autism Society of Greater Orlando will be hosting our 14th Annual Autism Walk & Family Fun Day inside the Orange County Convention Center's North Concourse on **Saturday, April 20, 2019 from 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM**.

As part of our on-going collaboration, ASGO has come up with a way to support our local schools, while meeting our mission of providing supports and services to individuals living with autism today.

Here is the proposal:

- 1. Purpose to increase the number of schools participating in the Autism Walk & Family Fun Day
- 2. Plan
 - a. Your school sets up a "Walk Team"
 - b. Name your walk team (most likely your school name)
 - c. Promote the event through flyers and e-mails
 - d. Register people for your walk team (Minimum 10 people per team)
 - i. Registration fee is \$15.00 per person for ages 3 to 17 and \$20.00 for participants ages 18 and above. This includes your admission and event t-shirt.
 - ii. Registration form must be completed and submitted with payment.
 - iii. Waiver must be signed at event
 - e. Raise pledge money by selling pieces of the Solving the Puzzle (please see attached participant registration forms for more information) Minimum 1 Solving the Puzzle per School (**Minimum** \$250 donation)
 - i. Ask for donations from family members, friends, co-workers, businesses, etc. with the goal of selling puzzle pieces for \$25.00 each (you can combine donations of less to make a \$25.00 puzzle sale) in order to complete an entire Solving the Puzzle for \$250.00.
 - ii. Hold fun awareness events (i.e. slime the principal, talent show, sell ice cream at lunch, etc). This could be used not only as a fundraising effort, but as an event to promote autism awareness.
 - iii. Ask local businesses to join the cause
 - iv. The more Solving the Puzzles you sell, the bigger the donation back to your classroom.
 - f. Meet your Walk Team at the Orange County Convention Center's North Concourse on Saturday, April 20, 2019 at 8:00 AM.
 - i. Wear your school shirts to promote your school
 - ii. Enjoy the exhibits, resource partners, kid friendly activities, massage area, etc.
 - iii. Participate in the event
 - iv. Enjoy yourselves and have some fun@
- 3. Benefit 100% of the funds raised stay right here in the Central Florida community to support families living with autism today. With that being said, what better way to give back then to reward schools for their participation. Therefore, we have set up some criteria whereby 25% of the pledges raised by the school will go right back to the classroom teacher to support your students with autism. The criteria is simply:
 - a. Register participants for your school walk team (minimum of 10)
 - b. Collect pledges for your school walk team (minimum of \$250)
 - c. Turn in all money at Check-In the day of the event (April 20, 2019)
- 4. Distribution of funds Once the event is over, ASGO will verify all donations received. Checks will be cut and delivered to each school. We are working in conjunction with the school districts to ensure that the money returned to the school will be spent on students with autism.

We truly appreciate all the support that we have received in the past. In these trying budget times, ASGO and our local school districts must work collaboratively to continue to meet the needs of our children with autism. Together we can make a difference!
